



Terms and Conditions

Booking & Deposits

Bookings are only guaranteed upon receipt of a deposit of £10 per player for bookings under £500. For events larger than \pounds 500 the management may reserve the right to request a higher level of deposit.

A deposit must be received a minimum of 30 days before the event date otherwise the tee times will be released to the general public. All bookings made with 30 days of the event date must pay at the time of enquiry. If there is extra demand for a date in the calendar, an earlier deposit payment date may be required.

Stevenage Golf & Conference Centre reserve the right to cancel a society day if a full deposit has not been received.

The account must be settled in full before play commences, unless an invoice has been requested and agreed with the finance department prior to the arranged date.

A minimum of 12 players must be paid for.

A society deposit cannot be refunded but can be transferred to another date if a minimum of 2 weeks' notice is given to Stevenage Golf & Conference Centre.

If a society fails to show on a pre-booked date, the society will be required to pay Stevenage Golf & Conference Centre the full booking amount.

Final numbers must be confirmed 72 hours before the event and Stevenage Golf & Conference Centre reserve the right to charge in full for confirmed numbers.

Where the actual attendance on the day is no more than 2 golfers less than the confirmed numbers the customer will be liable for any pre-ordered food and drink, but not the green fee for the absent golfers.

Pace of Play

Slow play must be avoided at all times. Course Rangers monitor the pace of play and have the right to ask players to speed up. If the pace of play does not improve, the Ranger can assist casual players to play through a society to help improve course conditions.

Buggies and Trolleys

The hiring of buggies are sold in good faith at the time of making a reservation. Buggies must be booked by individual players and the full cost of the buggy must be paid at the time of booking. The booking cannot be refunded but can be transferred to another player.

A decision is made at the start of each day by the Head Professional regarding the use of buggies and trolleys which can alter as the day progresses.

A maximum of two people are allowed per buggy and each buggy must be kept well away from the greens, surrounding area and tee boxes. There are limited number of buggies available so please book early to avoid disappointment. Trolleys are available on the first come first served basis and a small deposit is required at the time of hire.

Weather Conditions

In the event of adverse weather conditions, the Head Green Keeper will make the final decision regarding the availability of the course. If the course is deemed to be unplayable then a new booking date will be agreed between Stevenage Golf & Conference Centre and the society. No deposits will be refunded.

Course Rules & Etiquette

The rules of golf must be adhered to at all times. Groups must consist of no more than 4 players, each with their own clubs.

Help maintain the quality of the course by repairing pitch marks, replacing divots and raking bunkers. Local rules are on the scorecard. Green keepers have priority when working on the course.

Dress Code

All players must wear appropriate golf attire at all times whilst on the course.

- Polo Shirt
- Trousers or Tailored Shorts
- Golf Shoes or Trainers

Failure to comply with the dress code will result in access to the course being denied. Players will not be allowed on the course with bare chest, football shirts, vests, jeans or heavy boots.

Liability

Stevenage Golf & Conference Centre cannot accept responsibility for accidents, injury or misadventure. Players are responsible for making their own insurance arrangements in respect of any injuries caused to them, or caused by them to any third party.

Stevenage Golf & Conference Centre cannot accept any responsibility for the loss or damage to property belonging to any users'.

Users of Golf Buggies are responsible for any damages to them and repair pages will be expected, failing payment liability lies with the society as a group
